



Reporting Changes in Income



Reporting changes right away helps you get the right amount of benefits.

If you don't report changes and get too much by mistake, you will have to re-pay. Additionally, if you report changes, you may receive more benefits if you weren't receiving the right amount.



Income Types and Changes You Must Report

Every household receiving benefits **must** report things like getting a raise or promotion, working more hours, or if someone with income moves into your household. **Use the below list*** to help you identify income types or changes that you must report.



Wages or salaries (even if paid in cash)



Child Support



Tips and freelance/contract work



Self-employment income



Social Security



Gig jobs (Uber, Door Dash, Etsy, etc.)



Unemployment



Rent, dividends, or any other earned money

*This list does not include **all** income types or changes that you must report. Confirm with your county JFS office if you're unsure!
